Recognizing the need to ensure the health and safety of litigants, attorneys, visitors, court staff, judges, and other individuals entering the buildings housing the court; the court will implement the following protective measures:

- When individuals attempt to enter the court building, a staff person will ask the individuals if they are feeling feverish; have a cough, shortness of breath, or difficulty breathing; or have been in close contact with a person who is confirmed to have COVID-19. Individuals who indicate yes to any of these questions will be refused admittance to the court building.
- When individuals enter the court building, a staff person will use an infrared thermometer to determine the temperature of the individual. Individuals whose temperature equals or exceeds 100.0°F will be refused admittance to the court building.
- All persons not from the same household who are permitted in the court building will be required to maintain adequate social distancing of at least 6 feet.
- The maximum capacity of the courtroom will be restricted to 8 safe zones monitored and enforced by court staff.
- Hand sanitizer dispensers have been placed at the entrances to the building, outside of each courtroom, and in bathrooms.
- All individuals entering the court building will be required to wear face coverings at all times.
