- No additional budget funding
- Service implemented Sunday, September 5, 2021




### **Half Price Fares!**

From now through Dec. 31, fares are \$1 for one-way bus rides (regular and express routes), \$2 for one-way ACCESS rides, and half-price for multi-ride tickets.

TEXRail, ZIPZONE and TRE tickets are **not** discounted for one-way rides.

Multi-ride ticket pricing is \$2.50 for one day, \$1.25 for one-day reduced, \$12.50 for seven day, \$6.25 for seven-day reduced, \$40 for 30 day, and \$20 for 30-day reduced.














#### River Oaks Access Paratransit - September 2021





### Route 91 Boardings by Stop - September 2021





- 27- mile commuter rail line
- 52 minute ride from Fort Worth T&P Station to DFW Airport Terminal B
- Parking at all stations
  - except Terminal B and Fort Worth Central Station
- Level boarding- ADA compliant
- Travels over 70 mph
- 229 seats = total capacity 488
- Single Ride \$2.50
