CHS Homecoming Parade Thursday, Oct. 15

The CHS Homecoming parade and pep rally will be held on Thursday, Oct. 15. The parade will begin at 6 p.m. and will follow the traditional route from CHS: head north on Churchill Road, west on Barbara, north on Robert's Cut-Off, east on River Oaks Blvd., south on Long, east on Ohio Garden, and south on Churchill Road back to the high school. All participants must wear a mask at all times and are limited to a total of four people in the bed of a truck and eight people on a trailer. Following the parade, the community is invited to attend the tradition-filled pep rally and the Burning of the Letters ceremony to begin at approximately 7 p.m. The event will be held in the blue parking lot on the east side of W.O. Barnes Stadium. Masks will be required at this event.

Castleberry Curbside: Read, Return, Repeat

Castleberry ISD libraries are offering "Castleberry Curbside: Read, Return, Repeat." Providing library services and getting books into the hands of students and staff in the safest manner possible as campuses reopen is the top priority of Castleberry ISD Library Services.

This service will allow students to request and hold print books via their campus library Canvas page and pick them up at their campus during scheduled pick-up times.

Once holds are placed, library staff on each campus will pull the books and notify parents when the holds are available for pick-up. Students will be able to enjoy their library books for up to two weeks and are asked to return them to their book drop outside of their campus before or during their next scheduled pick-up time.

For safety purposes, returned books will be quarantined for four days before being checked in and therefore removed from the student's account. Tarrant CARES Rental Assistance Program

The Tarrant County Commissioners Court has allocated funds to assist with rental payments for those directly impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. Assistance is available on a first-come, first-serve basis for up to three months subject to periodic review of eligibility. Tarrant County will make final determination of eligibility and the amount of assistance provided.

Should you not be eligible for this program, you may be referred to another assistance program or organization. In order to receive assistance through this program, the property landlord must be willing to provide information to document unpaid rent and be a willing program participant. Any and all funds granted will be paid directly to the landlord.

If you have questions about the Tarrant CARES Rental Assistance Program or application, please email RentHelp@TarrantCounty.com.

Tenants must initiate the application process, but assistance funds will be sent directly to the Landlords. We encourage Landlords to work with their tenants and use this program before initiating the eviction process.




