Please ensure your residents know:

- Waste can be brought to the ECC or to a mobile event.
- The Crud Cruiser has mobile events on Saturday mornings.
- Mobile events are open to host city residents only.
- Proof of residency is required to use the ECC or a mobile event.
 - Current water bill:
 - Valid drivers license: and
 - Voucher if required by your city for billing purposes.
- Business and commercial waste **CANNOT** be accepted at the ECC or mobile events.

- Automotive fluids
- **Batteries**
- Cleaners & chemicals
- Cooking oil
- Lawn/garden/pool chemicals
- Light bulbs
- Medicines
- Paint & painting supplies

WHAT'S NOT ACCEPTED?

- Ammunition & Explosives
- Appliances & electronics
- **Building materials**
- Bulk trash & yard waste
- Butane/propane cylinders
- Medical waste
- Tires
- Asbestos/PCBs/radioactive items

Waste Handling Procedures

- Leave chemicals in original, labeled container. If unlabeled or not in the original container, please label contents clearly.
- Place leaking containers in a second container of like material (corrosives in glass, flammables in metal).
- Place items securely in the trunk of the car or bed of pickup.
- Remain in vehicle and allow staff to unload waste.
